

Two positions are available beginning July 1. Interested applicants should submit applications in ERAS beginning **December 1 and no later than March 31**. Please note late applications may not be considered. Interviews will be conducted between April and May. All applicants will have successfully completed an ACGME-accredited Cardiovascular Disease Fellowship Program prior to CCEP training.

Please submit the following documents in ERAS:

1. Curriculum vitae
2. Personal Statement stating why you want to train in clinical cardiac electrophysiology and future career goals (no more than 300 words)
3. Research Experience
4. USMLE Transcript
5. Medical School Transcripts
6. ECFMG Certificate and Visa Status if applicable*
7. Summative Evaluation from IM Residency and Cardiology Fellowship (if already graduated)

These documents must be uploaded by our program deadline:

1. Dean's Letter
2. Letters of recommendation: Cardiology Fellowship Program Director; two letters from research mentors and/or cardiology faculty who know you well. Letters should address your clinical skills, research experience, and potential for an academic career in Electrophysiology.
